This project included multiple sliding glass door systems, curtain wall systems, and in-swing terrace doors. This residence located in the Northeast uses our products to create a modern look while capitalizing on the amazing views of the area. We installed units in the main house, as well as the pool house on the property. The project called for impact testing on all of the products included. Solar received Florida impact certification on a butt glaze curtain wall specifically to meet project requirements and now offers as a standard impact product.

Nose Dive features two 12' tall center pivot folding glass window systems utilizing center hung trolleys on each panel.

This restaurant in Greenville, South Carolina brings the outside in to create a more spacious dining area while not being restricted to opening the unit on one side or the other. To accomplish this look and feel, the owners originally wanted an outfolding system, but local codes did not allow for a completely out-folding system. This alternative solution led to a great result.





This straight-eave double-pitch greenhouse located in the Northeast is suitable for growing plants while maintaining a traditional feel to the property. The project includes an evaporative cooler and a natural gas heater that are controlled by thermostat to manage the indoor environment. Circulation fans, greenhouse benches, and LoE 272 glazing were utilized for plant needs. While ring & collar ties, a Palladian arch, finials, a decorative gutter and ridge cresting add traditional touches.
